



The Winnebago Area Teen Coalition for Health (W.A.T.C.H.) received funding from Crossroads to support the coalition’s work during the 2017-2018 school year. This group meets throughout the school year to discuss topics including teen driver safety. The coalition has grown to now include 6 schools: Neenah High School, Oshkosh North High School, Oshkosh West High School, Winneconne High School, Omro High School and Menasha High School. The group participates in P.A.R.T.Y. (Prevent Alcohol and Risk Related Trauma in Youth) at the P.A.C. (Fox Cities Performing Arts Center), an annual program for high school sophomores focused on empowering students to make safe choices. This year the schools were able to order school-specific shirts and purchase handouts to distribute during their prom events. They also decided to purchase school-specific banners and pamphlets. Thousands of teens are reached by this group that continues to grow and work hard to ensure Winnebago-area teens are safe and empowered to make good decisions.
